

Please see below the latest Met Office update:

Friday –

Slowing improving picture across the whole region.

A band of precipitation expected (rain, freezing rain or snow moving up this morning) potential of freezing rain inland and on coast this morning leading to difficult conditions on the ground. There are currently reports of freezing rain falling across the South East – multiple accidents on M40, M25 so this weather type is currently present in the region and might fall in and around West Sussex later today. Further north and inland will more likely be snow. Most northern regions might get 1-5cm, all other southern areas a little less 1-2cm).

All weather will move north throughout the day ending up dry and cold by the evening.

A cold night is predicted creating icy stretches on untreated surfaces.

Saturday –

Temperatures will rise slightly leading to rain showers leading to slow thaw of any lying snow/ice.

Warnings will be updated to yellow later this morning. (here is the latest from hazard manager on map below).

New warnings issued to start at 00:05 on Friday 2nd March 2018 and end at 23:55 on Friday 2nd March 2018 – **LOW likelihood of MEDIUM impact**
