<p><b>Exploitation Prevention Conference</b> Email dated 17<sup>th</sup> September 2018, from Debra Young, HDC</p> <p>On behalf of Horsham District Council's Community Safety team I am pleased to invite you to our inaugural Exploitation Prevention Conference on Monday 8 October in The Conference Room, Parkside, Horsham from 9am – 1pm.</p> <p>The Conference has been organised in response to a growing concern nationally and locally that an increasing number of young people are becoming victims of criminal exploitation. The event is intended to raise awareness amongst professionals working in the District about exploitation – what it is, how to recognise the signs that a young person may be involved and where to go for support.</p> <p>The Key note speaker is Junior Smart, an ex-gang member who was groomed as an 18 year old to take part in violent criminal activity, arrested in his mid-twenties for possession of several kilograms of crack cocaine and sent to High Down prison in Surrey for 12 years. Junior has gone on to turn his life around; using his experience to help others.
