Fri 8 & 22 June 11:00am: Southwater (1) A 2½ mile flat circular walk along bridleways, country lanes and the Downs Link.. Meet in the Country Park car park (off Cripplegate Lane) RH13 7UN TQ 161258. Southwater Country Car Park Charge (50p for one hour £1.50 for up to 3 hours- Apr to Oct) (Free weekdays Nov to Mar) No stiles but not suitable for wheelchairs, buggies and prams, as can be muddy. Sun 10, 17 & 24 June 10:30am: Leechpool and Owlbeech Woods A lovely woodland 2½ mile walk, taking 1½ hours, generally following main paths and easy under foot, although a small part of the walk will be on narrower paths with tree roots, stubs and uneven ground.
