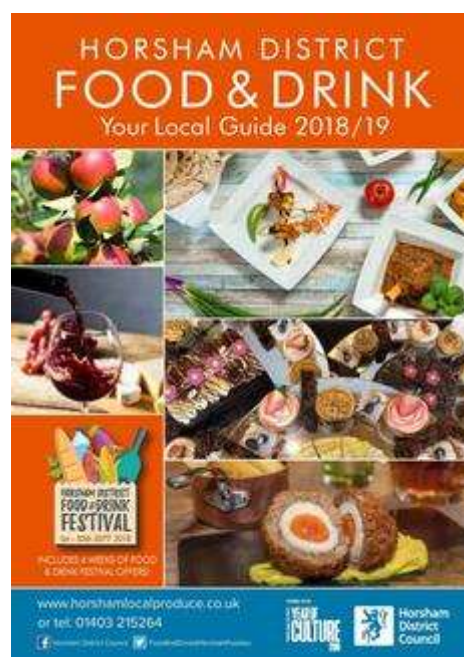
Don't forget to pick up this year's Food & Drink Guide at the Big Nibble event, direct from the Council and from local retailers.
