

PINK GIFT FAIR

Showcasing a treasure trove of stalls at the Pink Gift Fair this autumn....

A genuine mix of independent, inspiring stalls to tempt shoppers whilst being assured that for every £1 spent with stallholders 10% will be donated to the Brighton Cancer Research Laboratories that seek to find cures for all 200 types of cancer.

The Pink Gift Fair at Horsham council offices, Parkside, is part of Time Well Spent in Horsham events.

It takes place over the weekend of Saturday 16th and 17th September, from 9.30am to 4pm each day. Admission is £3 which includes a strip of raffle tickets. Parkside offers some parking for shoppers at a donation of £1 per vehicle

Outside the front of the venue visitors will find a vintage merry-go-round and sweet shop as well as glitter face painters, balloons and a Five Oaks Audi car display.

New for 2017 is an area for complimentary healthcare professionals offering taster sessions of reflexology, aromatherapy, psychic medium, reiki healing, sports massage, wellbeing through Emotional Freedom Techniques (EFT), and more.

Over 50 hand selected stalls await shoppers offering something completely different to the normal high street with Fabulous Fashion, Exquisite Jewellery, Gorgeous Gifts, Kids Collections and Toys, Prints and Stationery, Home Accessories, Food and Drink.

"This year looks set to be such an inspiring event at the new council offices and we have been delighted by the support to date from local people and business in building the PGF photograph wall of support, as together we can beat cancer sooner through shopping this September."

"We have to thank staff at Horsham and West Sussex council for their support in staging the fair at Parkside which offers modern facilities all under one roof," said volunteer organiser Sally Pavey, a Warnham resident. "For us volunteer organisers the most important thing is to raise as much money as possible to help find cures for cancer whilst offering something for everyone to enjoy."

One in two people born in the UK after 1960 will be diagnosed with cancer at some point in their lives. Right now, half of the people diagnosed with cancer will survive their disease for at least 10 years.

The aim is to accelerate progress and see 3 in 4 people surviving cancer for 10 years or more by 2034 but this can only be done through research and thus all the money raised from the fair will go direct to the Brighton research laboratories.
