Thank you for your covering letter and the enclosed 137 handwritten forms regarding the proposed development at Buck Barn/Weald Cross. This is to confirm receipt. Officers in the Planning Policy team will read and note their content.

As you know from earlier correspondence with you, the Local Plan Review includes the assessment of potential sites for development in order for us to meet the housing need in the District in accordance with Government requirements. The Buck Barn/ Weald Cross proposal is one of many sites that the council are currently assessing as part of our Local Plan Review and at the current time this process is still ongoing.

Again you will already be aware that the next key stage of the Local Plan Review process is the publication of the Regulation 18 Draft Plan which is programmed for February-March 2020 and will be subject to a period of consultation enabling all members of the public including Nuthurst residents to make comment on the content of the plan once it has become available.
