

Tree Felling, Golding Lane, Mannings Heath

In a remarkably short period of time, the owner of woodland along Golding Lane, felled a considerable number of trees and burnt them. The Clerk reported the action to: the Forestry Commission because a licence is required to fell more than 5 cubic metres of wood; to HDC's Tree Officer because some of the trees may have had a preservation order; and to WSCC because at least one felled tree was on land belonging to WSCC. Unfortunately, the ground is now completely cleared of all plant and wildlife.
