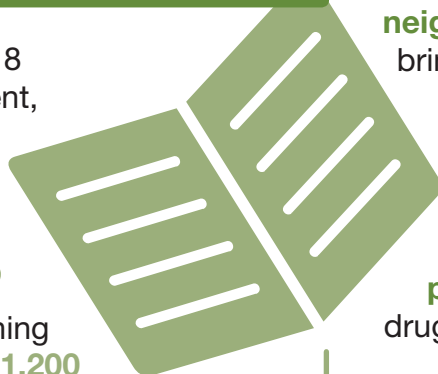
Community Safety

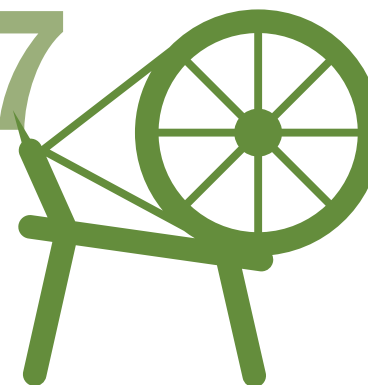
