Police appeal for witnesses to collision near Henfield

Police are appealing for witnesses following a two vehicle collision that occurred

about 11:18am on Saturday 27 July on the A281 at Crouch Hill, just north of Henfield.

A blue Suzuki Jimny travelling north was in collision with a silver Vauxhall Agila which was travelling south.

Sadly, a passenger in the Vauxhall, an 82-year-old local man, died from his injuries in hospital on 30 July.

No other serious injuries were reported.

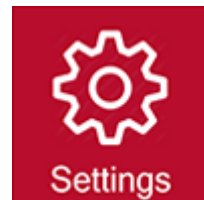
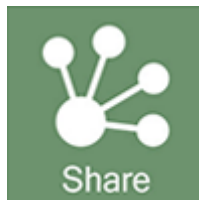
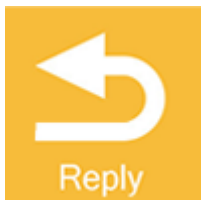
