

Household Waste Recycling Sites during lockdown

At the present time HWRS will operate as usual, pending further government advice. However, the government advice states that you should only leave the home for essential reasons, and as household kerbside collections will continue to operate, WSCC ask residents to carefully consider whether they need to visit a HWRS while the restrictions are in place.

When visiting a HWRS there will be certain measures in place for the safety of visitors and staff:

- The number of vehicles accessing the sites will be restricted. This may lead to queues at some sites, and visitors are asked to respect local residents and businesses by not blocking entrances.
- There will be no pedestrian access at any of the sites under the current social distancing measures.
- Social distancing barriers will be in place. Visitors will be directed into enclosed bays to dispose of their waste.
- Only one person will be allowed to get out of a vehicle unless strictly necessary. Please travel to the sites alone if possible.
- Site staff will not be able to help unload your waste and recycling.
- Residents may need to move their vehicle and repark in order to access different bays.
